The members of the Crawford County Board met in special session at the Crawford County Annex on Monday, November 24, 2025. County Board Chair, William "Bill" Burke, Jr., called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was given by all, followed by a prayer by Mike Delaney.

**ROLL CALL OF BOARD MEMBERS**

Upon roll call Charles "Chuck" Campbell, Michael Delaney, Cyndi Boyce, David Rains, Scott Sparks, Kim Wade-Decker, Jonathon Goff, Tim Bennett, Joe Campanella, and William "Bill" Burke, Jr. were present.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Cindy Baxter addressed the board with a few questions she wanted to ask. 1. What is the amount of the Forest Preserve Levy? 2. Why is the board cutting 2 deputy positions at the Sheriff's Office? 3. What are the new positions on the agenda and how are they being paid for?

Kirby Aikman spoke regarding the Forest Preserve. She has concerns about it closing. The Forest Preserve hosts the NOW Programs best fundraiser.

Esther Cha spoke, thanking the board for all that they do and also wanted to advocate for the Forest Preserve.

Cindy Grimm spoke in favor of the Forest Preserve.

Shane Robinson spoke from experience with the Forest Preserve budget and stated that they need to be able to maintain it.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**MOTION:** Joe Campanella motioned to approve Ordinance establishing job positions of Public Service Coordinator and an Assistant Public Service Coordinator. Kim Wade-Decker seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously upon roll call. *Ordinance 2025-O-08 pg. 1521*

**MOTION:** Joe Campanella motioned to Approve the ICRMT insurance renewal for December 1, 2025 to November 30, 2026. Chuck Campbell seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously with an "yea" vote.

**MOTION:** Scott Sparks motioned to place a Referendum for Public Safety Sales Tax of 1% to the Ballot for the March 2026 General Primary Election. Cyndi Boyce seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously upon roll call.

**MOTION:** Joe Campanella motioned to table the discussion and approval of Claim Forms. Jon Goff seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously with an "yea" vote.

**MOTION:** Jon Goff motioned to table the discussion and approval of Training Request Forms. David Rains seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously with an "yea" vote.

**MOTION:** Mike Delaney motioned to approve Ordinance amending the General Budget for Fiscal Year Ending November 30, 2025. Cyndi Boyce seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously upon roll call. *Ordinance 2025-O-09 pg. 1560*

**MOTION:** Jon Goff motioned to approve the County Energy Aggregate. Joe Campanella seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously with a "yea" vote.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**MOTION:** Chuck Campbell motioned to approve the Crawford County Forest Preserve Levy at \$104,000. Scott Sparks seconded the motion. Jonathon Goff motioned to amend the Levy to \$85,000. Kim Wade-Decker seconded the motion. Motion failed upon roll call with Scott Sparks, William "Bill" Burke, Jr., Chuck Campbell, Mike Delaney, Cyndi Boyce and David Rains voted "nay". Kim Wade-Decker, Jonathon Goff and Tim Bennett voted "yea". Joe Campanella abstained from the vote.

Chairman, William "Bill" Burke, Jr. requested for County Clerk, Beckie Staley, to do roll call on the original motion. Motion carried upon roll call with Tim Bennet, Joe Campanella, William "Bill" Burke, Jr., Chuck Campbell, Mike Delaney, Cyndi Boyce, David Rains and Scott Sparks voting "yea". Kim Wade-Decker and Jonathon Goff voted "nay". *Ordinance 2025-O-010 pg. 1561*
